

Background/Discussion:


At its January meeting, the City Council requested a report on alternative revenue sources to fund Wastewater Facilities improvements.

It is noted that the City has recently adopted Water, and Street facility plans, the Wastewater facilities plan is in the final stages of consideration, and a Storm Water facilities plan will be completed soon. Staff is recommending that once all of these plans are adopted, that a consolidated Capital Improvements Plan which includes alternatives for financing all capital improvements be prepared together with a schedule for completion of projects identified in the plans.

Gary,

Here is the plan(s). BTW, I have talked with Councilor Hamilton about this in the past.

Short term:

The new ball field we are building in Azalea Park (between the existing fields) will be available for t-ball this year that is we are planning to have the new backstop constructed in the next couple months. The little league group could come in with volunteers to assist our staff to prep a temporary t-ball field for them to use exclusively this year and maybe even next year, depending on how we schedule out the reconfiguration portion of the project.

Long Term:

Once the reconfiguration project is complete we will have two ball fields and a multi use field primarily used for soccer but could accommodate two t-ball fields as well. Once the fields are all weather turf, transition from one sport to another (t-ball to soccer) can literally occur in minutes. I also hope to one day have a majority of Little League function at Azalea Park so that we can transition into a Recreation Center at Bud Cross Park.


