} **RULE 9**


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows: that, in accordance with House Bill 3047, Chapter 432 revised November 8, 2013. The bill modified Oregon Revised Statutes ORS 809.210 and 809.220 to allow courts to issue and re-issue notices to suspend for Failure to Appear (FTA) and Failure to Comply (FTC).

Brookings Municipal court will allow an individual who has one or more citations that the license of the individual has become suspended due to failure to comply (payments) or failure to appear. To enter into this program one must adhere to a new payment plan informing the courts of any changes in address, phone numbers, employment or financial status. The individual must pay one-half of the amount owed or two hundred dollars, whichever is less; however, no payment will be accepted in a sum less than fifty dollars monthly. The court clerk will complete form, DMV OR 735-6115 and submit to the Department of Motor Vehicles to release sanctions on an individual's drivers license before the account is paid in full for Brookings Municipal Court traffic cases.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that, during the course of this program that an individual who fails to comply with terms of the agreement, action will be taken by the court to suspend the defendant's right to drive in Oregon through DMV without further notice and will not release it again until the case is paid in full. Further action will be taken by submitting the case to collections, additional 25% collection fee added, legal fees and garnishment of wages and bank accounts may occur.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that, applications for exceptions to this rule shall be presented to the judge for consideration.
