

**IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS
COUNTY OF CURRY, STATE OF OREGON**

RULE 9: License Release Program

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Oregon Revised Statutes 809.210 and 809.220 allow courts to issue and re-issue notices to suspend for Failure to Appear (FTA) and Failure to Comply (FTC) if certain conditions are met.
2. In accordance with the above, the Brookings Municipal Court will allow a defendant whose license has been suspended due to FTA or FTC to enter into a License Release Program (LRP).
3. To enter and continue in said LRP, defendant must do the following:
 - a. Enter into an agreement with the Court for a new payment plan. The minimum monthly payment shall be \$50.00 or 10 per cent of the amount owed, whichever is greater.
 - b. Inform the Court of any changes in defendants address, telephone number, employment and financial status.
 - c. Pay at least 50 per cent of the amount owed.
4. The Court Clerk will complete DMV OR 735-6115 and submit it to the Department of Motor Vehicles to release sanctions on the defendant's driver's license before the amount is paid in full for all Brookings Municipal Court traffic cases.
5. If, during the course defendant's participation in the LRP defendant fails to comply with the terms of the payment plan agreement, the Court will suspend the defendants' right to drive in Oregon through the DMV without further notice and will not release the suspension subsequently until all fines and fees are paid in full.
6. The Judge may approve exceptions and modifications to the above for good cause shown.
