RULE 14: Deceased Defendants and Aging Accounts

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. When notified by the Social Security Administration, newspaper obituaries or other government agencies that a defendant is deceased, the Court Clerk will complete a judgment for signature by the Judge allowing all fines and fees to be set aside.
2. With respect to #1 above, the Court Clerk shall release all license sanctions with the Department of Motor Vehicles associated with the deceased defendant.
3. When an unpaid judgment becomes 20 years old and has been determined by the City Manager to be uncollectable, the Court Clerk shall complete a judgment for signature by the Judge allowing all fines and fees to be set aside.
4. With respect to #2 above, any driver's license suspension shall remain in full force and effect until the original amount of fines and fees are paid in full.
5. The above provisions do not apply to liens recorded against the property of defendants for the purpose of collecting fines, fees and abatement charges.
